

CSAV Group News Update



As has been reported through mass media, the earthquake that struck central and southern Chile last weekend has caused great damage, impacting transportation, communications, and utility infrastructure in the area.

Please be advised that our transactional systems are functioning normally, and that we continue to accept cargo bookings to and from all our worldwide destinations as we can operate safely and timely.

While all vessels are 100% technically operative and no damage have occurred to them, some Chilean ports operations have been affected by these events.

Among the most relevant ports in Chile, status as of today is as follows:

- *Arica, Iquique, Antofagasta* and *Coquimbo* with normal activities.
- *San Antonio* and *Valparaíso* are both operative and attending vessels with some limitations.
- *San Vicente* port cranes remain in good condition. Port would be partially operative once power is restored and port authorities allow operations to start.

Our team continues to monitor the operational status of the affected ports, and we will update you on how the situation progresses.
