CSAV restructures Andex Services

Dear Customer,

We are pleased to advise new configuration for our services from Asia to Mexico and West Coast of South America / Central America. **Andex Services Sling 1 and Sling 2** will be operated as follows:

Andex Sling 1

Asia to Mexico and West Coast South America (Chile & Peru)

This sling will be operated with 11 / 8500 teu ships with following port rotation:

EB: Chiwan-Hong Kong-Ningbo-Shanghai-Pusan-Yokohama-Manzanillo-Balboa-Callao-Iquique-San Antonio-San Vicente

WB: San Vicente-San Antonio-Callao-Balboa-Manzanillo-Shanghai-Keelung-Chiwan.

Round voyage of 77 days.

We are adding a new direct call to Yokohama EB as well as direct calls to Balboa EB & WB.

The first sailing with this new configuration will be provided by MV CMA CGM Nabucco ETA Chiwan on October 18th, 2011.

Andex Sling 2

Asia to Mexico, Central America via Mexico, Colombia and Ecuador via Balboa.

This sling will be operated with 10 / 6500 teu ships with following port rotation:

EB: Xingang-Qingdao-Pusan-Shanghai-Ningbo-Xiamen-Hong Kong-Chiwan-Pusan-Manzanillo-Lazaro Cardenas**-Balboa-Buenaventura

WB: Buenaventura-Lazaro Cardenas**-Manzanillo-Yokohama-Xingang.

**Lazaro Cardenas being the new TS port for Puerto Quetzal-Acajutla-Corinto-Puerto Caldera.

Round voyage of 70 days.

This sling will maintain its excellent transit time from Asia to Central America, on the other hand will include direct call to Balboa EB offering connections with other services of the CSAV Group.

The first sailing with this new configuration will be provided by MV CSAV Puelo ETA Xingang on October 21st, 2011.
