



# Tariffs and Inflation

- Tariffs Effects
  - Relative prices vs Inflation
  - 2025: Rising Tariffs & Falling Inflation
- Tariff Revenue to date : \$200B
  - Passed on to consumers ? Import prices falling
- Consumer Price Index (CPI) covers US consumption
  - 2/3 of \$30T US GDP: \$20T
- Tariffs 1% of consumption
- Democrats on tax-incidence
  - Corporate taxes on US companies vs foreign

### Non-Tariff Barriers

(NTB) often equivalent to prohibitive Tariffs

- No entry
- Pharmaceuticals
  - EU Price Controls are NTB
  - US create most drugs but has large drug trade deficit
- Example of governments distorting trade flows



### Trading off Tariffs for NTB

## Tariffs are Lowered in response to Non-Tariff Gains

- FDI increased by trillions
  - Relative to \$300B/yr average
- Product specifications NTB:
  - Agriculture in EU
- Trade tariff relief even for domestic companies: Pfizer

The "TACO" labeling misleading

### Chile & US Tariff Policy

- Free Trade Agreement 2004-15
- US has small trade surplus \$5B with Chile
  - \$21B Imports/\$26B Exports
- Initial focus on top 4
  - Mexico & Canada (USMCA 90%), EU, China
  - 80% of Overall Trade: \$4.1T Imports/\$3.2T Exports
- Avenues for Chile in lowering new tariffs
  - Trade war seems not advisable
  - · Tariff and NTB that can be reduced
    - Outside FTA: Luxury goods, Alcohol
  - Production feasible to move to US
